## **Emissions reduction targets**

In order to continue our progress to achieving Net Zero, we have adopted the following carbon reduction targets.

Scope 0: Target: 0.04 reduction
 Scope 2: Target: 0.14 reduction
 Scope 3: Target: 0.04 reduction

We project that carbon emissions will decrease over the next five years to 3.5 tCO $_2$ e by 2025. This is a reduction of 6%

Progress against these targets will be reported in each annual review of this plan.



### **Carbon Reduction Projects**

#### **Completed Carbon Reduction Initiatives**

The following environmental management measures and projects will be delivered to achieve reductions as outlined above. These measures will be in effect when performing the contract.

In the future we hope to implement further measures such as:

- Support employees to use low impact transport- We will re-advertise the "cycle to work scheme. We have cycle storage and shower facilities at work. We will also offer all employees a season ticket loan.
- 2. Incentivise employees to buy electric vehicles for commuting to work We will introduce a benefit-in-kind scheme to incentivise employees to lease EVs.
- 3. We will liaise with the landlord to encourage them to use renewable energy we are renting our office and will liaise with the landlord to encourage them to switch to renewable energy.
